

## Notice Of Development Variance Permit Application


The Council of the Town of Sidney is considering the approval of a Development Variance Permit for 2042 Melville Drive (*property shown below*) during the regular Council meeting of February 10, 2025, that commences at 6:00 p.m. The proposed Development Variance Permit would vary the following section of Town of Sidney bylaws:

Zoning Bylaw No. 2275	Bylaw Requirement	Proposed
Section 5.1.9: Accessory Buildings and Structures	iii. not be located within a front or exterior side yard; and	Located in the front yard; and
	iv. be located no less than 1.2 metres from any lot line.	Located 0.7 m from the front and interior side lot lines.

The purpose of this Development Variance Permit is to permit the placement of an accessory structure in a front yard and to relax the minimum front and interior side setback requirements.
